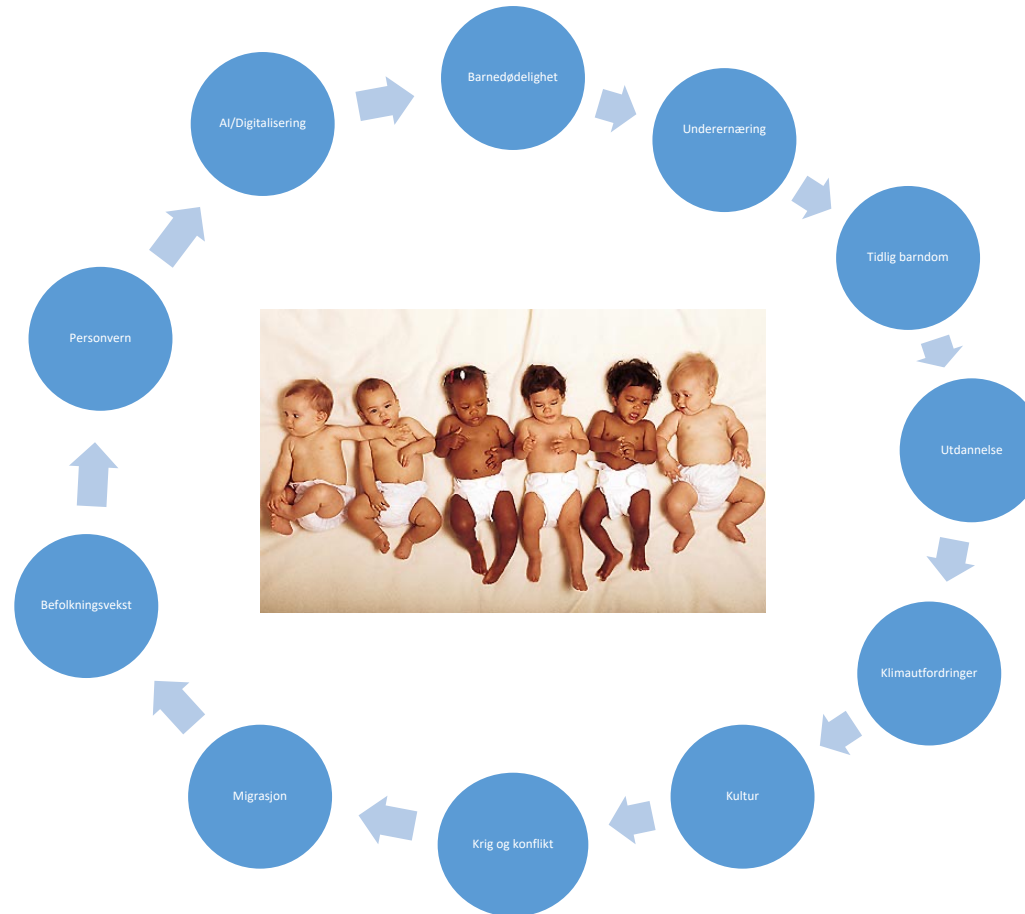




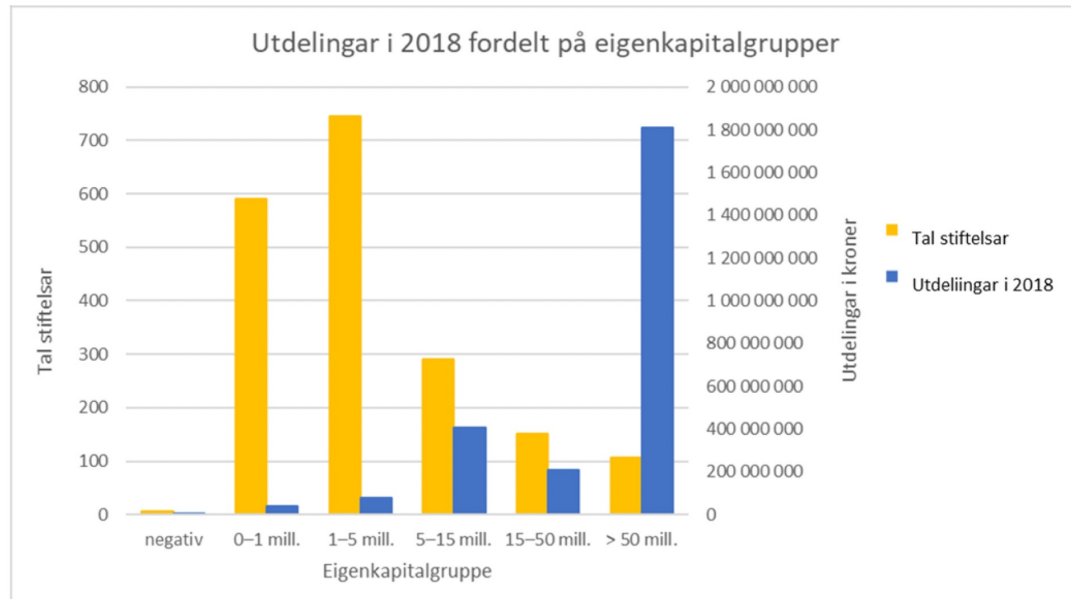

# Vi er stiftelser er stort sett ganske små....

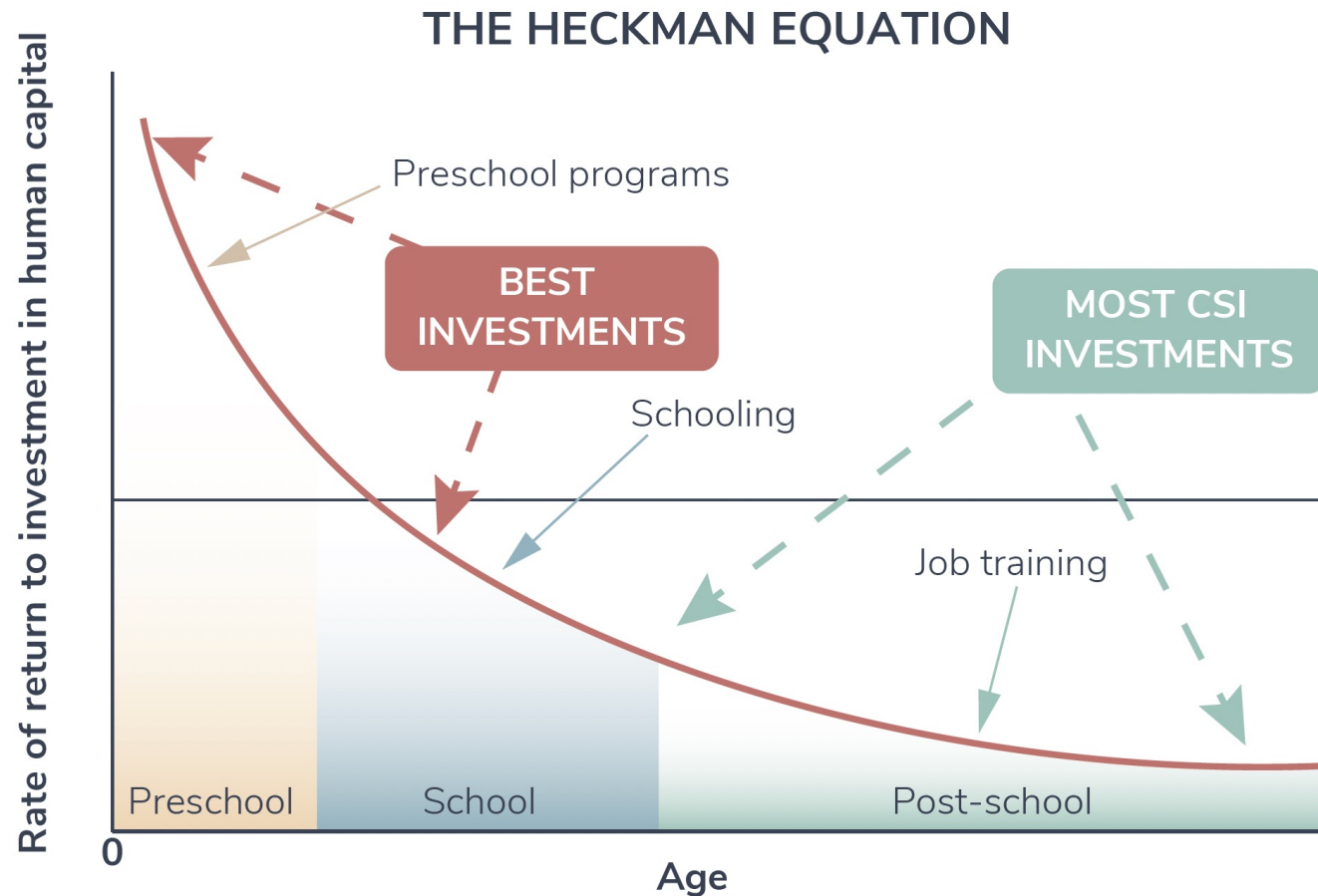

# Systemisk endring

## Major systemic changes happening now

The project has led to government plans to scale toddler care throughout Ethiopia - PfC is a preferred partner and an MoU is signed

The local authorities in Addis Ababa has launched an initiative to provide early childhood care for all children in the city – starting with **330 000** children from low-income households – PfC is asked to participate as technical partner, developing centre of excellence as well as community centres

**As a small operator, PfC has, together with partners revolutionized the early childhood care in a country of more than 100 million people**

## Early Childhood Care and Education

Quality Early Childhood education boosts performance of marginalised children later in school and careers

## Economic Independence For Women

Child-care enables women, especially mothers, to be employed, not quit their jobs and reach their full potential

## Job Creation

Establishment of day-cares provides new jobs and taxpayers, supporting the “common good.”

## Major shift in Ethiopia’s focus on toddler day care

Ethiopia’s investment was initially only in kindergartens, 4-7 years, with no focus on children below 4. The largest international educational project in Ethiopia, the Global Partnership for Education, similarly excludes children below 4.

**Through the Day Care Project, PfC ensured a strong focus and commitment to 0-4 early child education**

**The partnership of Grieg Foundation and PfC got the ball rolling.** The importance of 0-4 day care to the country’s overall socio-economic development is now largely acknowledged by all ministries and government offices
